Agriculture

In the Agriculture knowledge area, we primarily act as direct advisors to farmers.

PLANT PRODUCTION CONSULTATION. Our advisory services focus on both conventional and organic cultivation. Our individual consultation services go by the designation HIR, and usually include a crop rotation plan, field visits, economic follow-up, plant production letters and assistance with EU applications.

FINANCIAL ADVICE. Our financial advisors offer economic business consultation in decision-making and development of rural enterprise, through operational planning, strength/weakness identification in the business, calculations in buying real estate, leases, investments, and generation shifts and EU consultation.

CONSTRUCTION ADVICE. Our construction advisors' focus area is consulting with farmers planning conversion or construction of animal barns. The advisor produces drawings, tender outlines, licence applications and cost estimates, and performs control and inspection of construction projects.

TECHNICAL ADVICE. Our technical advisors work with field mechanisation issues, machine cost estimates, energy matters, and solutions for storing and preserving grain and roughage.



LIVESTOCK CONSULTATION. We normally collaborate with the Swedish livestock associations when it comes to providing consultation in the areas of meat and dairy production.

FIELD TRIALS AND APPLIED RESEARCH. We have long experience of working with field trials for means of production, crop cultivation systems and mechanical solutions. The results provide our advisors with a continuous stream of new knowledge.

SOIL MAPPING AND ACREAGE CALCULATION. We can help you with everything from soil sampling to consultation regarding the new soil map. We can also measure the area of your farmhouse and gardens.

DRAINAGE PLANNING. We can plan and specify your field drainage project through field surveys, drain-distance planning and dimensioning.
